<u>Classroom Requirements</u>

- Pencil case
- 3 sharpened beginners pencils (the triangular shaped pencils are very good)
- coloured pencils for everyday use
- a pencil sharpener
- an eraser
- a pair of scissors (left handed if necessary)
- 4 glue sticks (1 to be brought into school and 3 to remain at home until required.)
- a small ruler
- 4 whiteboard markers (1 for school and 3 back up to remain at home until required)

Art Materials

- a painting apron or old shirt to protect clothes during art lessons
- a set of watercolour paints (approximately 12 colours in the box)
- a packet of coloured pencils
- an A3 art folder

Sport Requirements

- indoor shoes (sports shoes)
- shorts/leggings
- T-shirt
- PE bag (preferably with elasticized/ drawstring)

Other Requirements

- a school bag clearly labelled with name, class, tel. Number, bus/tram number and bus/tram stop.
- a pair of slippers or indoor shoes
- a small cloth, tea-towel or napkin to cover the table when eating
- a waterproof lunch box to keep food separate from books and a water bottle
- a box of tissues (these will be shared by all children gradually through the year)

Class Fund

Class Fund is payable to the teacher in September and then administered by the Class Representatives. It is €80.
