ALL ITEMS MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED!

1 large schoolbag, big enough to hold Homework box, pencil case, lunchboxes and drink bottle

1 large pencil case in which all following items can fit

- Minimum 2 sharpened pencils (extras can be put aside in September and used later when needed)
- Coloured pencils, sharpened
- A pencil sharpener
- A pair of scissors (left-handed if necessary)
- 4 large glue sticks (high quality glue, 3 will be collected in Sept, one to stay in the pencil case)
- A transparent ruler (small to fit into pencil case e.g. 15cm)
- 1 highlighter any colour
- 2 erasers (one to be collected in September and used when needed)

Other:

- A small packet of paper tissues – will be collected in September and shared as needed
- A pair of slippers or indoor shoes
- A strong A4 cardboard or plastic file/box to hold their homework items each day (homework box)
- A plastic/fabric cover/purse and chain to hold their own school identity card around their neck (children are responsible for taking care of their own card in 2nd class during their trips to the library and canteen)
- 1 clear A4 plastic folder with button to hold Oxford Reading Tree work (ORT)
- 3 Lever arch files Width 5cm: red, blue and green (new children to the school only)

Art Requirements

- A painting apron or an old shirt to protect clothes during art lessons
- A large art folder to hold their art work for the year
- Paint box (Approx. 12 colours) (Art materials to be purchased by new children to the school only)

Physical Education Requirements:

- Indoor sport shoes, not black soled
- Shorts/tracksuit bottoms
- T-shirt
- PE bag and swimming bag (big enough to carry swimming gear and can be easily carried over the shoulder)
- Swimming suit
- Towel

For your information:

Lever arch files, art aprons, paint boxes and whiteboards that were used in the 1E classroom will be transferred to the 2E classroom. At the end of 2nd class, these are then transferred to the classroom for 3rd class.

The teacher will purchase all other books and materials during the summer holidays, which will be paid for by the class fund. Therefore, the 2nd class teacher asks that the class representative collects the class fund in June 2018 so the books can be purchased and shipping arranged so the books are here for September.

The class fund is 80 Euro per child.
