

Swedish teacher (m/f/d) (Mother Tongue)

The European School of Karlsruhe offers education to approx. 1000 pupils, in three linguistic sections (DE, EN, FR), from 3-18 years.

We require an experienced teacher (m/f/d) of **Swedish** to European Baccalaureate level (A-Level) for the secondary school. Applicants must have a **Degree**, **PGCE** or equivalent teaching **qualification** and be a native speaker. Experience in international or European schools would be an advantage. The position involves around 8 -12 hours of teaching in the secondary classes.

The successful candidate will be working under the authority of the Director of the European School, in a multi-lingual, multi-cultural environment, in a school with an outstanding academic record. The European Schools are official educational establishments controlled jointly by the governments of the Member States of the European Union. In all these countries they are legally regarded as public institutions. There are currently 13 European Schools in 6 countries.
