Integrated Science teacher m/w/d **– European School Karlsruhe (Germany) –**

We require an experienced teacher (m/w/d) of **Integrated Science (classes S1, S2 & S3 / age 11, 12 & 13)** for the secondary school **from the 01.09.2021**. Applicants must have a **Degree, PGCE or equivalent teaching qualification** and be a native English speaker or equivalent. Experience in international or European schools would be an advantage. The position involves **8 - 12 periods of teaching** (1 period à 45 minutes) in the secondary classes.

The successful candidate will be working under the authority of the Director of the European School, in a multi-lingual, multi-cultural environment, in a school with an outstanding academic record. The European Schools are official educational establishments controlled jointly by the governments of the Member States of the European Union. In all these countries they are legally regarded as public institutions. There are currently 13 European Schools in 6 countries.
