The European School System



- The first school was established in 1957.
- There are a total of 13 European Schools (Brussels 1,2,3,4, Mol, Luxembourg 1&2, Alicante, Bergen, Frankfurt, Munich, Varese and Karlsruhe)
- and 22 Accredited Schools in the system.
- The ESK: in Karlsruhe since 1962







Key Features of the European Schools



- Three language sections at the ESK (German, English and French)
- From Nursery through Primary to Secondary culminating in graduation
- with the European Baccalaureate, internationally recognised and
- allowing worldwide opportunities to study
- Multilingual education in all EU languages as mother tongue
- High-quality tuition and a high level in languages,
- Qualified native speaker teachers
- An Online Teaching and learning platform that works since several years






European Baccalaureate (EB)


 A non-profit association, in which all families at the European School Karlsruhe can become voluntary members (Fee 30 € per year/family)



Healthy snack, play time outside of kindergarden, arts and crafts and games in the classrooms of the Primary School building.





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


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
