

JOB OFFER European School Karlsruhe – Germany

A teacher for Secondary School to teach: Economics to start on the 1st of September 2024 / 4h per week

The European School of Karlsruhe offers education to approx. 1000 pupils, in three linguistic sections (DE, EN, FR), from 3-18 years. We require a teacher of **Economics in English** in class 9 (S4) of the secondary school (<u>link to the syllabus</u>). Applicants must have a **Degree, PGCE or equivalent teaching qualification** and **at least the B2-C1 level in English.** Experience in international or European schools would be an advantage. The position involves 4 teaching hours (4 x 45 min) which will take place in situ.

The successful candidate will be working under the authority of the Director of the European School, in a multi-lingual, multi-cultural environment, in a school with an outstanding academic record. The European Schools are official educational establishments controlled jointly by the governments of the Member States of the European Union. In all these countries they are legally regarded as public institutions. There are currently 13 European Schools in 6 countries. The European School of Karlsruhe is located in one of the most dynamic regions in Europe. The city of Karlsruhe is located between Baden-Baden and Heidelberg, very close to the French border.
