### **Class Materials:**

- Large schoolbag (big enough to hold homework folder(s), pencil case, lunchbox and water bottle)

#### Other:

- Pair of slippers/indoor shoes
- Strong A4 cardboard or plastic folder to hold homework items each day (homework folder)

- Lever-arch folder, width 5cm (the files from Class 1 will be passed on to Class 2 for returning students)
- Box of tissues will be collected in September and shared as needed throughout the year
- Gardening gloves
- Rain boots
- Bicycle helmet for cycling lessons
